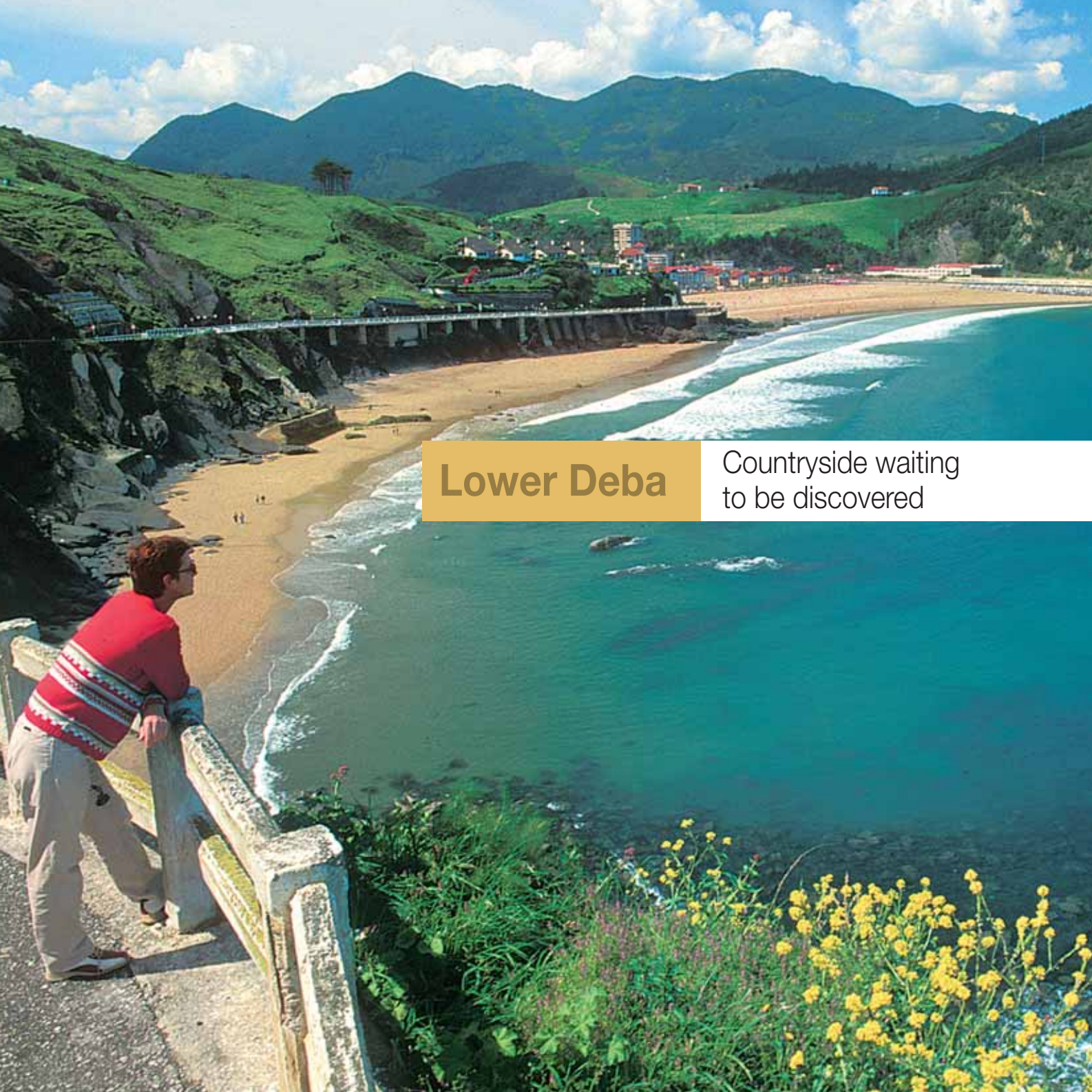

The River Deba comes out onto one of the wildest stretches of the coast of Gipuzkoa, with impressive cliffs that shelter some extraordinarily beautiful coves that are difficult to get to, and an area of great ecological and geological importance, the tidal plain located between Deba and Zumaia. There is a break in the steep coastline in Deba, which is the largest resort in the area, with a pleasant promenade, a lovely beach and a delightful temple, the Church of the Virgin Mary, a jewel of Basque Gothic that has been declared a National Monument. A few kilometres from the centre of Deba, the Shrine of Itziar has an image of the Virgin from the 13th century, surrounded by a beautiful plateresque altarpiece. The other coastal town in the area, Mutriku, has a completely different character. Its extremely well preserved historical quarter, which has been declared a Historical Monument zone, has a simple maritime feel to it. Mutriku has some highly recommendable rural districts such as Astigarribia, and although they are some distance from the town itself, the relatively wild beaches of Saturrarán also form part of Mutriku.

The most surprising landscapes in this area marked at both its ends by the sea and intensive industrialisation are in the central part, in the green, hidden tangled valleys of Lastur, Kilimón and San Lorenzo, that are undergoing a significant degree of development as tourist attractions because of rural tourism.

The upper part of the area is made up of clearly industrial towns such as Eibar, Elgoibar, Soraluze-Placencia de Armas, and Mallabia and Ermua, which belongs to Bizkaia. All of them have some extremely interesting sights, such as the Church of St Andrew and the Shrine of Arrate in Eibar, the Baroque monuments in the main square in Elgoibar, the Royal Church of the Virgin Mary in Soraluze-Placencia de Armas or the Palaces of Valdespina and Loviano in Ermua. You can round off your visit by tasting the famous chocolates of Mendaro and enjoying some rural scenery in Mallabia.

The predominant features of the built-up part of Orio, a fishing village located at the mouth of the River Oria, are the aroma of grilled fish – the most typical is red bream – and the silhouette of the Church of St Nicholas de Bari, that forms part of the town's system of defences. A long promenade alongside the tidal inlet leads to the town's main beach. Between Orio and Zarautz, it is worth turning towards the interior and heading into Pagoeta Park. This is perfectly fitted out for a wonderful day out, and here you can visit the Agorregi ironworks complex. This route also gives you the chance to get to know Aia, against a backdrop of farmhouses and woods.

Along with Donostia-San Sebastián, Zarautz is the biggest tourist resort in Gipuzkoa. It has a long beach – well-known among all surfers because of the quality of its waves- marked by a promenade that has become a museum of open-air sculptures. The old part of Zarautz clearly shows how important the town was long before tourism was invented, and has some extremely interesting historical monuments.

It also has a great many natural, artistic and gastronomic attractions. Getaria is the birthplace of the sailor Juan Sebastián Elkano and the fashion designer Cristóbal Balenciaga and the homeland of Txakoli. Visiting its old quarter is a must, as is the Gothic parish Church of San Salvador. Getaria has two beaches; one on each side of the narrow strip of land that is has been built on. At the end of this isthmus, the Mount of St Antón, the "Mouse of Getaria", is an excellent place to take a pleasant walk. Zumaia also has two beaches, Itzurun and Santiago, which are quite different from each other. In its old quarter the Gothic church of St Peter stands out, and in the area around the modern marina, two small but interesting museums are worth visiting: the Zuloaga Museum and the Beobide Museum. Once you are in the interior, Zestoa is a town with a long traditional of thermal baths that has a magnificent spa.

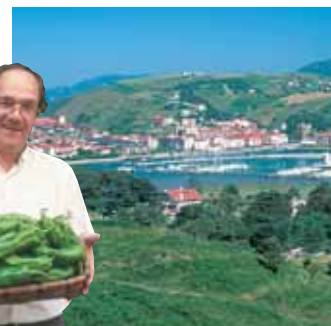

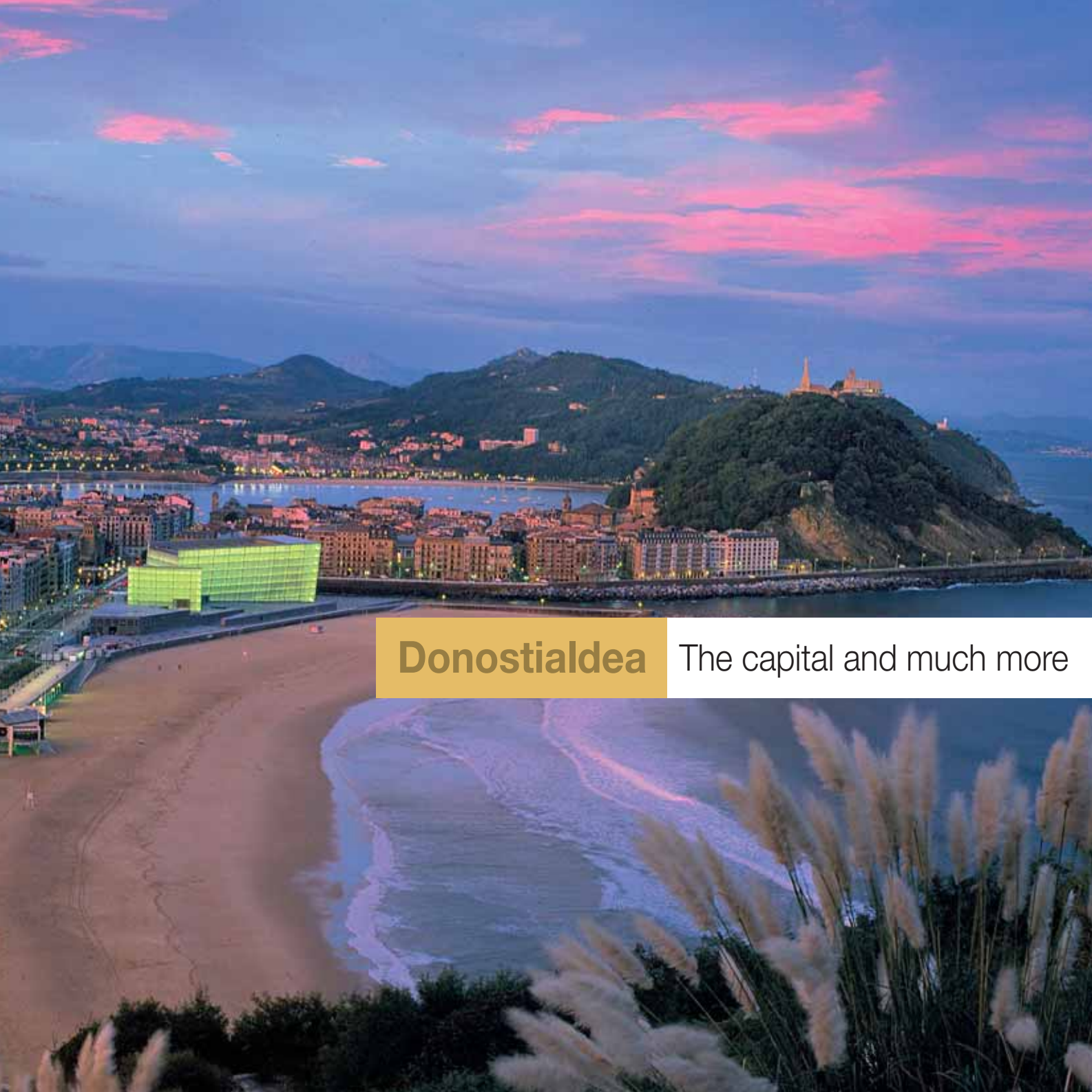

Summing up the tourist attractions in Donostia-San Sebastián can turn out to be protracted, but it is quite simple, because it is a city that has practically everything: three magnificent beaches; a perfect bay; one of the most typical and lively old quarters in the Basque Country; a long tradition of tourism that results in excellent services; impeccable parks; top-quality cultural events; a very long promenade by the sea that allows you to stroll along the entire seafront without walking over a single zebra crossing, marked by an interesting route of sculptures; streets with elegant classical architecture and examples of the most contemporary buildings, such as Rafael Moneo's Kursaal; a cuisine that, apart from not requiring any introduction, is tailored to meet the requirements of all budgets and palates...

However, Donostia-San Sebastián also offers the possibility of going a bit beyond all this, to discover new developments such as Miramón, which houses an interesting Science Museum, or of going deeper into the surrounding area. Astigarraga, for example, is recommendable at any time, but it becomes a must during the cider-house season (from January to March or April, approximately). The "Cider Route" also includes Urnieta and Hernani, one of the oldest towns in Gipuzkoa, in whose historical quarter you can find some outstanding monuments such as the Church of St John the Baptist or the Convent of St Augustine. The Zabalaga farmhouse in the municipal area of Hernani is also old, (16th century), and has been fitted out by the Chillida family to house the Chillida-Leku Museum. Andoain, with an interesting Baroque parish church, is also the entry-point to the protected biotope of Leizarán. Lasarte-Oria, likewise, provides access to the extensively beautiful meadow of Zubieta, which belongs to Donostia-San Sebastián, and which the river Oria runs through. On the opposite side of the river, Usurbil also has an important cider-making tradition and a district, Aginaga, which has an exquisite delicacy, young eels, called after itself.

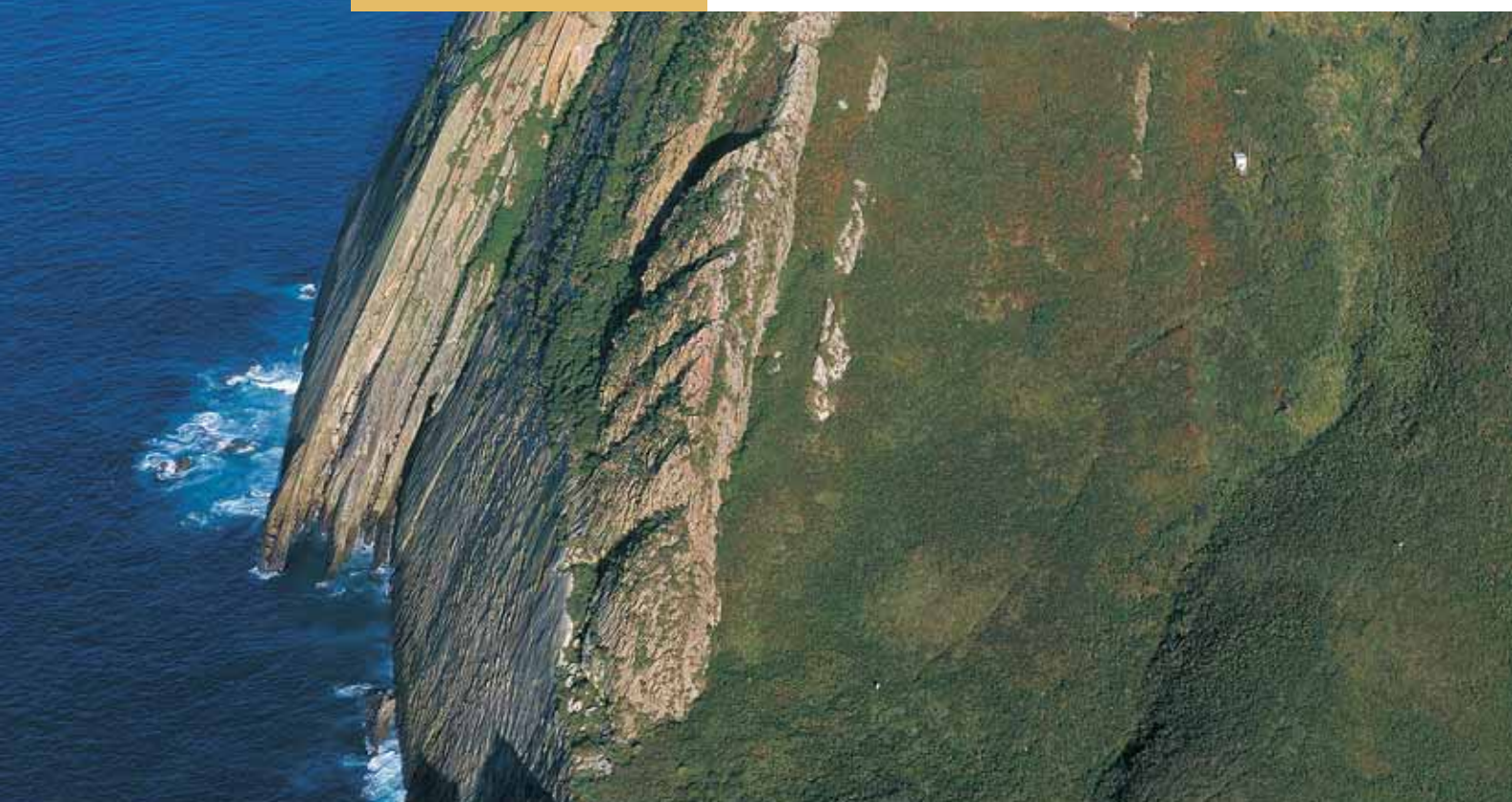

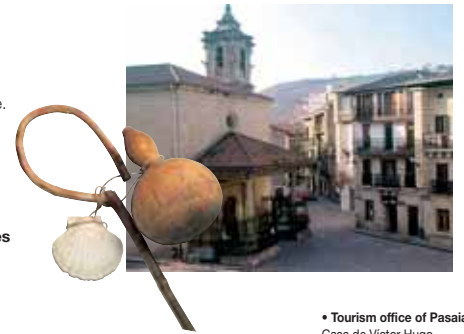
**G**ipuzkoa is a province with contrasts, but if there is any area of Gipuzkoa where you can talk about extreme contrasts, then this is Oarsoaldea, whose relatively small size reinforces the feeling of variety and of being able to enjoy totally different experiences in a single day.

The most marked contrast occurs between Oiartzun and the towns closest to the Bay of Pasaia. At the foot of Aiako harria, an extremely important geological monumental granite formation that has been turned into the Aiako Harria Nature Reserve, Oiartzun has a markedly rural feel, not only in the built-up area but also in the relatively scattered districts that make up the town. Oiartzun is nature, it's green, it's wooded, it's water, it is an invitation to talk a relaxing walk – it has a long pleasant path fitted out for bicycles and pedestrians that runs through the valley- or for the most extreme sporting adventures. It is also prehistory, as well as history; it is genuine Basque culture.

However, Pasaia, Lezo and Erreterria are also more than what they seem to be on first sight. They are clearly densely populated towns with some extensive industrial zones - linked in many cases to the intense activity in the port, which nevertheless, conceal some pleasant surprises. Some of these are connected with nature: enjoying the excellent views provided by the Fort of San Marcos or the Landarbaso woods in Erreterria; climbing, from Pasai San Pedro and Pasai Donibane respectively, up Mount Ulia and Jaizkibel; looking out to sea from both sides of the mouth of the port; discovering the deep green grasslands of Lezo... Others are connected with a history that lives on in the old quarters of the three towns: the traditional maritime flavour of Pasai Donibane – a district that is dotted with interesting sights, and a counterpoint to the huge number of cranes in the port; the medieval layout of certain streets in Erreterria or the unusual figure of Christ with a very light beard, shrouded in legend, that is revered in Lezo...

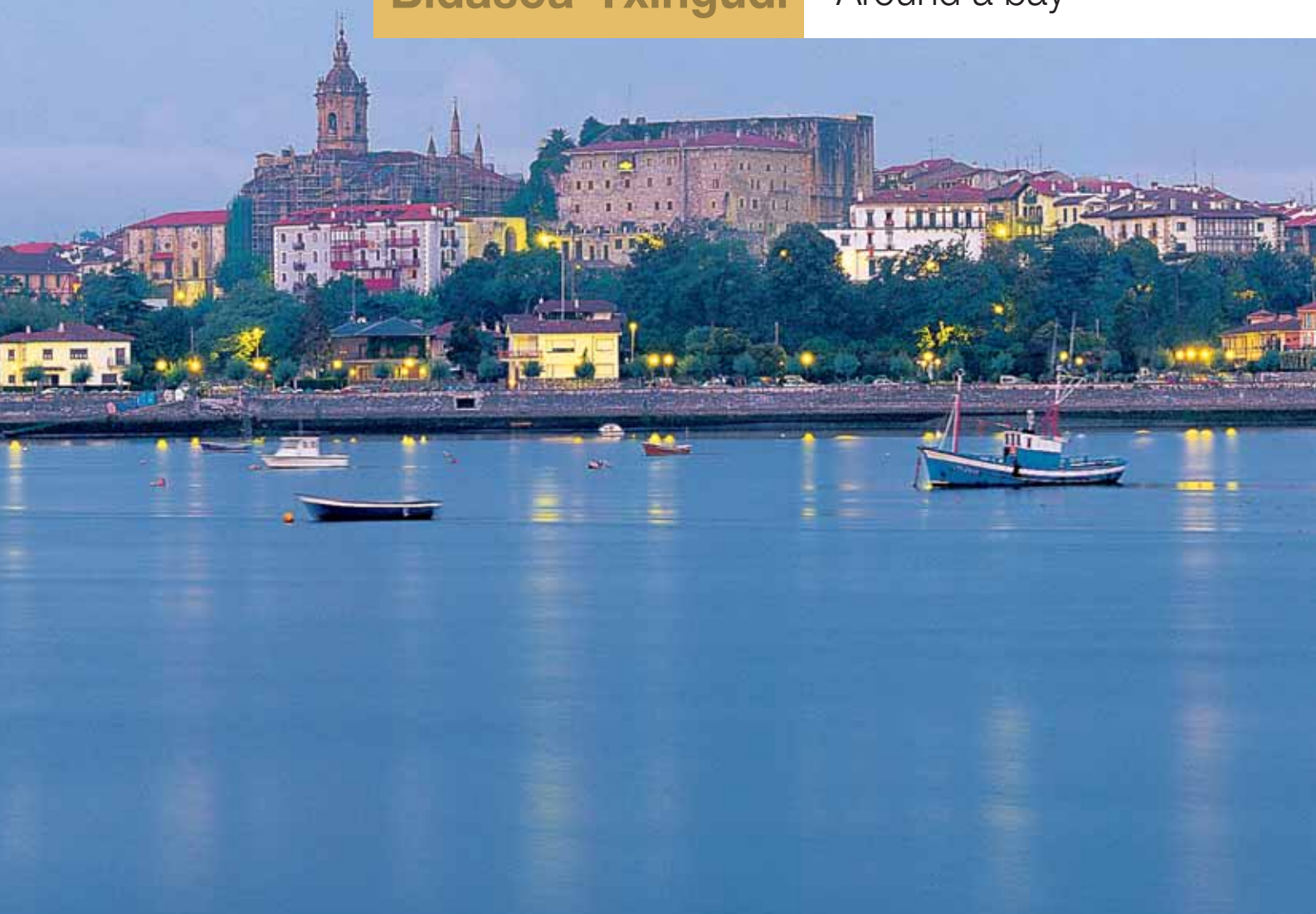

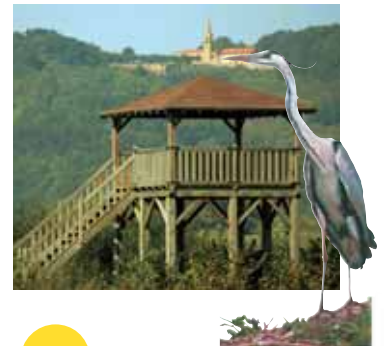
Apart from the beauty of Txingudi Bay, its natural charms and rich history, if there is something that characterises the Bidasoa Txingudi area then it is the exemplary way in which it has been able to combine the special characteristics of the three towns that make up the area, to create a single tourist package in which leisure tourism and business trips, Summer rendezvous at the beach and timeless rendezvous with history, and culture and tradition, all exist side by side.

Irun has always had the enterprising cosmopolitan character of a border town, and has managed to establish a significant presence for itself on the tourist scene in Gipuzkoa. Its brand-new FICOBA showground, Basque Coast International Fair, is an important centre for activities connected with business tourism, but Irun, together with neighbouring towns, also offers an attractive package for tourists connected with history, its artistic and cultural heritage and its natural surroundings. The Museum of Romanisation in the Bay of Biscay or the Plaiaundi Wind farm, a must for thousands of birds during their migrations and for all nature lovers, are two of the interesting tourist attractions in the area.

Hondarribia and Hendaye – linked to each other by a practical powerboat service- have some obvious tourist attractions: both have exceptional beaches, supplemented in the last few years by their respective modern marinas. While Hendaye is basically a residential town that is at its liveliest during the summer, in the spectacular monuments in the old quarter of Hondarribia you can still feel the passage of time and weight of history. Sheltered behind its walls in the steep streets that lead to what was once Emperor Charles V's castle are a series of exceptionally interesting stately buildings. At its foot, the picturesque Marina district reminds us that Hondarribia has been and still is, above all, a town with its roots in its maritime calling.

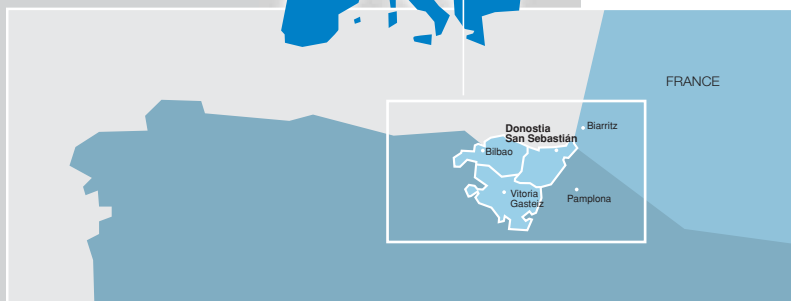
